ONLINE ABHIDHAMMA LECTURES

SAYALAY DAW VIMALANANI is a Nepalese nun who has studied with and was trained by Ven. Sayadaw U Pandita in Myanmar since 1991. In 1999, she completed the Sasanadhaja Dhammacariya degree which qualifies her to teach the Buddhist scriptures. Currently she teaches in the International Buddhist Meditation Center in Nepal and abroad. She translated "Yamaka Pali", the sixth book of the Abhidhamma Pitaka, from Pali to Nepali.

The Abhidhamma Pitaka is one of three baskets (Pali: *pitakas*) constituting the Pali Canon, the scriptures of the Theravada Buddhism.

The primary concern of the Abhidhamma is to understand the nature of the experience, the conscious reality. To understand this, there is made a detailed analysis of the reality as it presents itself in meditative introspection. It is shown that the ultimate reality consists of a multiplicity of fundamental components, which are called *dhammas*. *Dhammas* fall into two classes. The unconditioned *dhamma* that is solely *nibbana* and the conditioned *dhammas*, which are the material phenomena (*rupa*), the mental factors (*cetasikas*) and consciousness (*citta*).

The focus of the two days Abhidhamma Lectures will be Chapter VII, the Compendium of Categories. In this chapter the ultimate realities (citta, cetasika, rupa and nibbana) and its 72 entities get arranged into different categorical schemes that fall under four headings: a compendium of defilements; a compendium of mixed categories, which include items of different ethical qualities; a compendium of the requisites of enlightenment; and a compendium of the whole, an all-inclusive survey of the Abhidhamma ontology.
