

# 1. Hetu paccayo

### **Root Condition:**

The six roots<sup>1</sup> are related to the states<sup>2</sup> associated with the roots and to the matter produced thereby<sup>3</sup> by root condition.

# 2. Ārammaņa paccayo

Ārammaṇapaccayo'ti:

- (1) Rūpāyatanam cakkhuviññāṇadhātuyā taṃsampayuttakānañca dhammānam ārammaṇa paccayena paccayo.
- (2) Saddāyatanam sotaviññāṇadhātuyā taṃsampayuttakānañca dhammānam ārammaṇa paccayena paccayo.
- (3) Gandhāyatanam ghānaviññāṇadhātuyā taṃsampayuttakānañca dhammānam ārammana paccayena paccayo.
- (4) Rasāyatanam jivhāviññānadhātuyā tamsampayuttakānañca dhammānam ārammana paccayena paccayo.
- (5) Phoṭṭhabbāyatanaṃ kāyaviññāṇadhātuyā taṃsampayuttākānañca dhammānaṃ ārammaṇa paccayena paccayo.

### **Object Condition:**

Visible object is related to eye-consciousnesselement<sup>4</sup> and its associated states<sup>5</sup> by object condition.

Sound is related to ear-consciousness-element and its associated states by object condition.

Smell is related to nose-consciousness-element and its associated states by object condition.

Taste is related to tongue-consciousnesselement and its associated states by object condition.

Tangible object is related to body-consciousness-element and its associated states by object condition.

Visible object, sound, smell, taste and tangible object are related to mind-element<sup>6</sup> and its associated states by object condition.

All *dhammas*<sup>7</sup> are related to mind-consciousness-element<sup>8</sup> and its associated states by object condition.

Grasping any *dhamma* as object, these *dhammas* arise: consciousness and mental factors. The former *dhamma* is related to the latter *dhammas* by object condition.

# 3. Adhipati paccayo

# 4. Anantara paccaya

Anantarapaccayo'ti:

#### **Predominance Condition:**

Predominant wish (*chanda*) is related to its associated states and to the matter produced thereby by predominance condition.

Predominant effort ( $v\bar{v}riya$ ) is related to its associated states and to the matter produced thereby by predominance condition.

Predominant consciousness (*citta*) is related to its associated states and to the matter produced thereby by predominance condition.

Predominant investigating wisdom (*vīmaṃsa*) is related to its associated states and to the matter produced thereby by predominance condition.

Grasping any *dhamma* as an outstanding object, these latter *dhammas* arise: consciousness and mental factors. The former *dhamma* is related to the latter *dhammas* by predominance condition.

### **Contiguity or Proximity Condition:**

Eye-consciousness-element and its associated states are related to mind-element<sup>9</sup> and associated states by contiguity condition.

Mind-element and its associated states are related to mind-consciousness-element<sup>10</sup> and its associated states by contiguity condition.

Ear-consciousness-element and its associated states are related to mind-element and its associated states by contiguity condition.

Mind-element and its associated states are related to mind-consciousness-element and its associated states by contiguity condition.

The four immaterial aggregates<sup>45</sup> are mutually related to one another by co-nascence condition.

The four great essentials<sup>46</sup> are mutually related to one another by co-nascence condition.

At the moment of conception, mind<sup>47</sup> and matter<sup>48</sup> are mutually related to each other by co-nascence condition

Consciousness and mental factors are related to mind-produced matter by co-nascence condition.

The great essentials are related to derived matter by co-nascence condition.

Material phenomena are sometimes<sup>49</sup> related to immaterial (i.e. mental) phenomena by conascence condition.

Sometimes<sup>50</sup> they are not related by co-nascence condition

# 7. Aññamañña paccayo

### **Mutuality or Reciprocity Condition:**

The four immaterial (i.e. mental) aggregates are related to one another by mutuality condition.

The four great essentials are related to one another by mutuality condition.

At the time of conception, mind<sup>51</sup> and matter<sup>52</sup> are related to each other by mutuality condition.

# 22. Natthi paccayo

### Natthipaccayo'ti:

Samanantara-niruddhā cittacetasikā dhammā paṭuppannānaṃ cittacetasikānaṃ dhammānaṃ natthi paccayena paccayo.

#### **Absence Condition:**

Just ceased consciousness<sup>98</sup> and mental factors are related to the present consciousness<sup>99</sup> and mental factors by absence condition.

# 23. Vigata paccaya

Vigatapaccayo'ti:

Samanantara-vigatā cittacetasikā dhammā paṭupannānaṃ cittacetasikānaṃ dhammānaṃ vigata paccayena paccayo.

#### **Disappearance Condition:**

Just disappeared consciousness and mental factors are related to the present consciousness and mental factors by disappearance condition.

## 24. Avigata paccayo

Avigatapaccayo'ti:

- (1) Cattāro khandhā arūpino aññamaññam avigata paccayena paccayo.
- (2) Cattāro mahābhūtā aññamaññam avigata paccayena paccayo.
- (3) Okkantikkhane nāmarūpam aññamaññam avigata paccayena paccayo.
- (4) Cittacetasikā dhammā cittasamuṭṭhānānaṃ rūpānaṃ avigata paccayena paccayo.
- (5) Mahābhūtā upādārūpānam avigata paccayena paccayo.
- (6) Cakkhāyatanam cakkhuviññāṇadhātuyā taṃsampayuttakānañca dhammānam avigata paccayena paccayo.

### **Non-disappearance Condition:**

The four immaterial aggregates <sup>100</sup> are mutually related to one another by non-disappearance condition.

The four great essentials are mutually related to one another by non-disappearance condition.

At conception, mind<sup>101</sup> and matter<sup>102</sup> are mutually related by non-disappearance condition.

Consciousness and its mental factors are related to mind-born matter by non-disappearance condition.

The great essentials are related to derived matter by non-disappearance condition.

Eye-base is related to eye-consciousness-element and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

- (17) Yam rūpam nissāya manodhātu ca manoviññāṇadhātu ca vattanti. Tam rūpam manodhātuyā ca manoviññāṇadhātuyā ca taṃsampayutatkānañca dhammānam avigata paccayena paccayo.

Ear-base is related to ear-consciousness-element and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

Nose-base is related to nose-consciousness-element and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

Tongue-base is related to tongue-consciousnesselement and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

Body-base is related to body-consciousness-element and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

Visible object is related to eye-consciousnesselement and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

Sound is related to ear-consciousness-element and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

Smell is related to nose-consciousness-element and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

Taste is related to tongue-consciousness-element and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

Tangible object is related to body-consciousnesselement and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

Visible object, sound, smell, taste and tangible object are related to mind-element and its associated states by non-disappearance condition.

Depending on this matter<sup>105</sup> mind-element and mind-consciousness-element<sup>106</sup> arise. That matter is related to mind-element, mind-consciousness-element and their associated states by non-disappearance condition.
